### Therapeutic Research

-Research designed to discover, develop, or evaluate the efficacy drugs for various diseases, including safety assessment.  
 •Study design: (RCT) the gold standard.  
 •Alternative design: Non-RCT.

### Prognostic Research

-Studies focusing on factors that can predict disease outcomes.  
 •Developing and validating accurate prognostic models.

### Diagnostic Research

-Evaluates the capability, accuracy, and clinical utility of methods or devices used in diagnosing various diseases.

### Etiologic Research

-Investigates causal relationships between risk factors such as behaviors, chemicals, genetics, or environmental exposures and disease outcomes.

### Diagnostic Research

-Developed a chest-pain triage tool that rapidly identifies cardiac cases requiring emergency referral, markedly reducing outpatient mortality.



### Adverse-Event Study

-Documented a 37-year-old Thai male with fixed drug eruptions on legs, arms and back after Etoricoxib 90mg, highlighting the risk of Etoricoxib-related SCARs for clinicians.



### Constipation-Relief Product & Clinical Trial

- Isolated bioactives from a traditional formula to create a “shot powder” that eases constipation and promotes regular bowel movements.
