1. The College

In 1999 (B.E. 2542), the Applied Thai Traditional Medicine Course (3-year certificate level) was developed as a cooperation between Rajamangala Institute of Technology and Institute of Thai Traditional Medicine, Ministry of Public Health. Later in 2004, the course was extended to Bachelor of Science (Applied Thai Traditional Medicine) as a 4-year program and a credit transferred 2-year program. In accordance with the Rajamangala University of Technology Thanyaburi(RMUTT) Act 2004, commencing on 18 January 2005, the Thai Traditional Medicine College (TMC) was established on 25 December 2006.

2. Academic and Supporting staffs
